When? After dinner

Nose: Citrus and floral

Palate: Vanilla followed by flowery fruitiness

Finish: Clean medium length

Old Pulteney 12 year old 40%

'The most Northern distillery in Scotland located in Wick. Located only 250 yards from the harbour. Perhaps that gives it the salty aftertaste?'

When? Aperitif

Nose: dry

Palate: light smooth and clean

Finish: slightly salty

The Dalmore 12 year old 40%

'Possibly my favourite distillery. The master blender for Dalmore, Mr Richard Patterson is one of the industry's extroverts. His passion for whisky is quite incredible.'

When? Nightcap

Nose: orange and chocolate

Palate: sherry and spice

'One of the more powerful Islay malts in terms of peatiness and an iconic Islay distillery.'

When? Nightcap

Nose: Peat, smoke and citrus
Palate: Peat followed by a touch of liquorice.
Finish: Smoky and Long

Highland Park 12 year old 40%

'From Orkney this is a wonderful entry level malt and a great all rounder. Has all the elements of a classic malt whisky.'

When? Dessert

Nose: Honey sweetness with smoky peat
Palate: Dry smoky and sweet
Finish: Heathery with slight smoke

'Fascinating distillery from Islay that has created some remarkable whiskies, namely the Octomore, the most heavily peated whisky ever.'

'The Edinburgh malt and the closest distillery to the Canny Man's. It traces its origins back to the early 19th century and is well worth a visit.'

When? Aperitif

Auchentoshan 10 year old

'From just outside Glasgow this is a classic lowland malt that uses triple distillation. Light but certainly not bland.'

When? Aperitif
Nose: vanilla, citrus
Palate: sweet
Finish: long, soft

'Glasgow's other distillery only 12 miles from the city centre although technically a highland malt.. A very drinkable malt whisky.'

Founded in 1820 this distillery took its name from an old gate to its native cathedral city of Brechin. The distillery closed its doors in 1983 when the downturn in demand for malt whisky became too much for it to take. Becoming increasingly rare and difficult to find.

Nose: dry, grassy

Palate: tropical fruit, toasty

Finish: brisk, dry

St Magdalene 19 Year Old
Lowland, Linlithgow

Distilled 1979

Licensed in 1797 but possibly earlier in eastern Linlithgow West Lothian. In 1983 the distillery closed down. There are still bottlings being released but they are becoming much rarer now.

Nose: aromatic

Palate: malty liquorice, big for a lowland

Finish: robust and peaty

Hillside 25 Year Old
Highland, Montrose

Distilled 1971

62.0%

Founded in 1898 the distillery was renowned for its unusually large stills. Closed production in 1985 at a time many others were doing the same. Very rare.

Nose: woody

Palate: pear, sweet fruit

Finish: dry toasted
